COTSWOLD WALKS

These circular walks usually take place on the first or second Saturday afternoon of each month, a longer one of 5-6 miles for the Ramblers and a shorter one (usually less than 3 miles) for the Amblers. Full details and any alterations to the schedule will be noted on the Cambray website calendar and in the weekly news and email to regular walkers. Car parking is not always easy so it is a good idea to turn up early and shared vehicles can be a bonus. It is advised that you bring suitable footwear, preferably boots, plus an adequate waterproof. If it is fine then you can always leave them in the car! Maps and mobile phones are useful options! Lunch at the venue indicated will be organised normally by asking folk if they wish to join a group booking.

1. **September 9th Arlingham** –Lunch at the Red Lion. Meet near to the Red Lion to start Gloucester Cattle Route, at 2pm.
2. **October 7th Northleach** – Lunch at The Old Prison. Move cars to Northleach centre after lunch to start walk at 2pm.
3. **November 4th Coopers Hill** – Lunch at Prinknash Tea Room. Meet in Car Park on A46 to start walk at 1:30pm
4. **December 2nd Eastleach Villages** – Lunch Sherborne Arms in Aldsworth (tbd). Walk starts at 1:30pm near to the Victoria Inn.
5. **January 6th Elmley Castle to the Combertons** – Lunch at The Queen Elizabeth Inn in EC (a good pub owned by the community). Easy to park there to start the walk at 1:30pm
6. **February 3rd Guiting Power** – Lunch at The Farmers Arms. Meet nearby to start walk at 1:30pm.
7. **March 2nd Daffodil Way Circular** – Lunch at The Beauchamp Arms in Dymock (a community-run pub). There is a free public car park off Western Way, in Winding Pool Close. The walk starts here at 1:30pm to see the wild daffodils
8. **April 1st Easter Monday Special - Gateway Centre via Cerney Wick** – Meeting at the Gateway Centre, to start at 2pm - Circular walk via canal and lakes towards Cerney Wick. Total 4 miles with shorter options
9. **April 6th Wyck Rissington** – Lunch at The Rose Tree restaurant or The Den in Bourton (tbd). Park in the British Legion car park in Bourton, cost about £3 a day cash payment in honesty box. Walk starts here at 2pm to see the snakes head fritillaries, which are quite spectacular.
10. **May 4th Cam Peak** – Lunch at The Old Spot, Hill Road Dursley Meet at 2pm in Dursley at location tbd to start the walk when the peak will be covered in bluebells.
11. **June 1st Burford to Swinbrook** – Lunch in Burford at Huffkins or Café Fifteen (tbd). Walk starts at 2pm at location tbd
12. **July 6th Snowhill** - Lunch in the Snowhill Arms, and there is a free car park nearby; there is also an NT one for the manor which is free to NT members. Walk starts at 2pm to include seeing the lavender.
