THINKING ABOUT MEMBERSHIP AT CAMBRAY?

- ◆ have put your trust in Jesus as your saviour
- ◆ have been baptised as a believer by immersion
- ◆ are walking with Him as Lord
- ◆ wish to join with God's people in the work of God through Cambray

If you have not yet come to know Jesus as your savior or have not been baptised, please talk to one of our Pastors.

Membership at Cambray is not an "institutional" thing. The Great Commission (Matt 28:18-20) urges believers to be committed to the ongoing process of making disciples – and this is the heart of church membership!

Believers should be welcomed into a community of fellow disciples who seek to share the Gospel and encourage each other to grow more and more like Jesus (Col 3:12-14, Eph 3:11-16). It is a commitment to Jesus, but also to one another - to journey through life together, praying with each other and seeking to help each other to grow in Christ.

The Great Commission urges believers to be committed to the ongoing process of making Disciples. This is the heart of church membership!
