

We believe ...

Foundations are important and we, as a church family, seek to stand on God's in our teaching, vision and direction.

Cambray exists to proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and our only Saviour - in our lives, our speech, and all that we do. We are Jesus ruled, elder led, living under the teaching of God's word, the Bible. We sum up our mission in three simple words - love, grow, go.

The greatest commandment is to LOVE God with all our heart, mind and strength and we can only do this if we know him. So we are gather together to hear his Word and to respond.

Together we are called to GROW in Christ-likeness so we aim to equip each believer to be a disciple-making disciple.

God clearly commands us to GO to make disciples of all nations wherever the Lord scatters us during the week and so we encourage every member to speak clearly and boldly of Jesus to those around them.

In common with many evangelical churches we have a reformed theological position. Our church Statement of Faith is available on our website at www.cambray.org/new-here/what-we-believe/. We hold to these Biblical truths as of primary importance. Other issues on which believers may disagree we agree to not divide over, "keeping the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace".

What happens on a Sunday?

We take God's call to love Him with all our heart, mind and strength seriously and so, at the centre of our gathered worship, is God's word. We work through the Bible, learning together and seeking to apply His word into our daily lives.

We currently hold a service every Sunday at 10.30am and occasional evening services at 6.00pm. On the first Sunday of every month, at 9am, we also hold *Gateway* for adults with learning difficulties.

During most Sunday morning services children aged 3-16 leave part-way through to join their own groups (see page 6). There is also a crèche for the under 3s and a room where parents can take babies if they are unsettled (whilst still listening to the service).

Our morning service typically last for an hour and a half and consists of a time of praise and worship led by a band, Bible reading, prayer and a talk. Our sung worship is contemporary whilst seeking to use the best of godly songwriters across the years.

After the morning service, tea and coffee is served in the main church - if it's lovely weather, we sometimes gather outside in the forecourt.



What happens during the week?

We take God's call to make disciples seriously and so we invest strongly in small groups of many kinds where we learn more about God, get to know each other better and invite others to join with us.

Small groups

Throughout the week we have many groups meeting together for fellowship and study. Some share food together, some focus on studying the Bible, others gain strength from praying for each othermany do all of the above! We



encourage everyone to be part of a small group as this is where we can care for each other most effectively. For more info, email smallgroups@cambray.org.

Fun & friendship

Walking, badminton, football - groups for all these things take place during the week. We also have a programme of social events for ladies - brunches, quizzes - and activities for men are organised too. And if you're from overseas we have an

Discipleship & Training

Throughout the year, we run mid-week Training Nights and we also run a variety of courses such as *Christianity Explored* and *Freedom in Christ*.

What's available for children?

At Cambray we have a thriving children's ministry, providing Bible-centred, fun, safe, life -relevant and age-appropriate groups for each young person to grow in their walk with God.

During the week....


B.L.A.S.T, Fridays, 6-7.30pm

What's available for teenagers?

There's lots going on for teenagers too - we aim to disciple our young people to become mature, faith-filled Christians, impacting positively on the world around them.

On Sundays...

Sunday Youth takes place during the Sunday morning service and is for all those in school years 7 to 11. Sessions are varied and dynamic involving drama, games, discussions and powerful prayer times.

During the week

Mondays: 7.30-9.00pm

A discipleship group for older teenagers (14 to 18 year olds) which meets

in the Upper room.

Fridays: 7.30-9.00pm
A social time of games, fun and chat for everyone in school years 7 to 9 and 10 to 13.

How to give




Standing Order - this is the easiest way to regularly give. Please complete a Standing Order form (copies by the Giving Boxes on the wall) or set-up via your own online banking.
