Purpose	The position of Cleaner is an important post in the life of Cambray Baptist Church, making a vital contribution to the smooth running of the church. There are two key purposes to the role:
	The Cleaner ensures that all of our rooms and spaces are ready for use by the congregation on a Sunday, the many other people that use our building throughout the week, and for any ad hoc events that take place, such as weddings.
	2. The Cleaner plays a vital evangelistic and pastoral role, in conjunction with and as part of the wider staff team. At times, the Cleaner may be the only person available to respond to immediate gospel and pastoral opportunities created by our regular flow of unplanned visitors. They must be willing and pro-active in seeking and responding to such opportunities, which may include prayer and Biblical counselling.
Responsibiliti es	Keeping the Church premises clean, hygienic and tidy. The premises include many varied rooms and spaces, including: Main church (and balcony); Schoolroom; Offices; Rodney Hall; Creche; Upper Room; Kitchens; Toilets; Various connecting corridors and stairs
	Undertaking kitchen laundry on a weekly basis (using the equipment on the premises)
	Reporting broken fixtures and fittings
	Checking stock of cleaning supplies, toilet rolls, etc to ensure supplies are always available.
	Carrying out bigger cleaning tasks on a termly or annual basis





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	Ensuring work is carried out in a safe way and that the premises are left safe for other users  Representing Jesus, the Pastors and the Church (as you may be the only
	person on the premises at times) by giving a friendly welcome to visitors and applying your faith to God-given opportunities created by their visit, including by providing Biblical pastoral support to those who may be seeking prayer, Biblical counselling or direction. You can expect to have unsolicited questions from visitors about our Christian motivation and beliefs, and your faith specifically. You will be proactively seeking opportunities to share the gospel through personal witness (1 Peter 3:15)

This includes taking part in and contributing to staff prayers, as well praying in private for our ongoing work (Ephesians 6:18). Time spent in attendance at formal staff prayer meetings and staff Bible studies count towards your working hours.
	You will actively contribute to our collective promotion of Christian motivation and practice in our work and working relationships, and contribute to a working environment of mutual Christian encouragement and growth (Matthew 18:15-17; Psalm 133). You will help us to maintain and develop a cohesive Christian community, being a part of the one body of Christ by the unity of one spirit.
